# OUR MASS TRANSIT FUTURE BY HAMPTON ROADS TRANSIT

We have invited HRT to provide us with an overview of the current status of the "Virginia Beach Transit Extension Study," an evaluation currently underway with the City of Virginia Beach to consider the potential of a fixed extension of Norfolk's light rail system from Newtown Road to the Virginia Beach oceanfront along the inactive Norfolk Southern railroad right of way. The study is analyzing a Light Rail Transit alternative, a Bus Rapid Transit alternative, Enhanced Bus Service, and a no build scenario.

HRT will provide a PowerPoint presentation, which will address transportation scheduling, station locations, right of way challenges from Birdneck Road to the oceanfront and various other issues.

HRT wants to bring our community up to date on their progress — more importantly, they want our feedback and input. Our transportation future is in the making! Interesting and worthwhile is an understatement. JOIN IN!





#### LYNNHAVEN RIVER DREDGING

The location selected several months ago at the foot of Thalia Creek on Virginia Beach Blvd., remains the city's current site of choice for the removal of dredged materials from the Western Branch of the Lynnhaven River.

The city has now obtained the required permit for the Whitehurst disposal site. If all goes well, dredging will begin in late 2010 or early 2011. Plans for the long-term use of the Thalia Creek location include public use for boat launching and other river activities.

We have also now learned that as many as three additional locations may be provided, in order to address ongoing private dredging projects in the northern and eastern part of the Lynnhaven watershed.

### WITCHDUCK ROAD WIDENING

In case you missed the announcement in March, a groundbreaking ceremony **finally** occurred, and the improvements are currently underway for the widening of Witchduck Road from Greenwich Road near the 264 Interstate to Bonney Road near the Princess Anne intersection.

The \$27.5 million project will be 2 years in the making and will convert the roadway from 4 lanes to six lanes with a median; and better yet, 10' wide paths on both sides of the road for biking, walking and running. The roadway currently handles 30,000 cars per day and can be a real headache to use during peak travel hours. \$10.6 million in federal stimulus money was contributed to help fund the project.
